SKI YACHTING - RULES OVERVIEW

Open to all GYC members aged 16 years or older

Ski Races

- Each team has max. of 4 skiers per team
- Each skier obtains a random start number upon registration
- Skiers compete at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. A disclaimer must be signed.
- Each skier completes two easy giant slalom runs, with the objective to be as consistent as possible in the two runs.
- The smallest time difference of the two best skiers in each team determines the ranking of the team after the skiing part of the competition.
- Team ski ranking determines starting point in the match racing competition.

Match Racing

- Each team appoints 2 skippers. The same skippers must sail all races.
- Match races are sailed on America's Cup remote controlled boats, which have been tuned to be identical in performance. A coin toss decides the boat choice and starting position.
- Wind conditions are created by wind machines. Wind conditions are light.
- Teams ranked 1st to 4th after skiing are guaranteed a place in the "Quarter Finals"
- Teams ranked 5th to 8th after skiing are guaranteed a place in the "Qualifications"
- All other teams must sail the "Repechage". The skiing results also determine the line-up of the "Repechage". All teams will sail at least one match.
- Exact details of match racing line-up, as well as number of regattas per match, will be communicated once the exact number of teams is known. Due to time constraints, we may have to adjust the format accordingly on the day.
- Sailing instructions and match racing rules, including starting procedures, right of way and penalty procedure, will be distributed to all competitors upon registration.
- Team Captains/Skippers must attend the Skipper's meeting
- Match racing rules will be modified and simplified and will be administered by International Match Racing judges, whose decision is final.

These rules may be subject to change. Any changes will be communicated during the registration and/or team briefing.

A clinic is organised on Saturday morning, 3rd March at 11h00 in the pool. Please bring your expertise, questions and enthusiasm and what's missing will be explained by Adrian and Andraz.
